**MBS International Airport Commission
Airport Concessions Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (ACDBE) Program
Fiscal Year 2017-2019 Overall Goal**

Pursuant to the U.S. Department of Transportation Regulation 49 CFR 26.45 titled, “**Participation by Disadvantaged Business Enterprises in Department of Transportation Financial Assistance Programs,**” the MBS International Airport Commission announces its overall goal for its ACDBE Program for Fiscal Year 2017-2019.

The MBS International Airport Commission proposes the adoption of an overall goal of **1.00%** for Fiscal Year 2017-2019. Census data available for geographic market for non-car rental and car rental concessions of Midland, Bay and Saginaw Counties, indicate that there currently are no Certified ACDBE’s within our service area. Also, no ACDBE’s have expressed interest. No known potential opportunities are anticipated during 2017-2019 goal period. The goal of 1.00% is solely derived from the fact that we are no longer allowed to state 0.00% as a goal.

The proposed 1.00% goal will be available for review and comment at the airport’s administrative office on Thursday, November 10, 2016 at 10:00 a.m.

The goal setting process that has been utilized by the MBS International Airport Commission to establish its annual overall goal provides an opportunity to consult with minority, women’s and general contractor groups, community organizations, and other officials or organizations which could be expected to have information concerning the availability of ACDBEs and non-ACDBEs. The MBS International Airport Commission seeks to establish a level playing field for the participants of ACDBEs within the MBS International Airport Commission geographic market area of Midland, Bay and Saginaw counties.
