Any person holding unescorted access authority on December 6, 2001, who had a disqualifying criminal offense listed above on or after December 6, 1991, must by January 7, 2002, report the conviction to the Airport Operator and surrender the SIDA access medium to the Airport Operator. Each individual with unescorted access authority who has a disqualifying criminal offense must report the offense to the Airport Operator and surrender the SIDA access medium to the Airport Operator within 24-hours of the conviction or the finding of not guilty by reason of insanity as per 49 CFR 1542.209(1). Failure to comply is subject to TSA enforcement action.

I affirm that the information I have provided on this application is true, complete, and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief and is provided in good faith. I understand that a knowing and willful false statement on this application can be punished by fine or imprisonment or both (See section 1001 of Title 18 United States Code).
